TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM ARCH ROAD TO MORMON SLOUGH IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

San Joaquin County - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform maintenance and install k-rail on State Route 99 (SR-99) from Arch Road to Mormon Slough.

Work will occur at the following locations:

- The southbound off-ramp from SR-99 to Arch Road will close beginning Sunday, October 7, 2012, through Friday, October 12, 2012, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The #2 (right) lane on southbound SR-99 from Arch Road to Mariposa Road/ before Mormon Slough will close beginning Wednesday, October 10, 2012, through Thursday, October 11, 2012, from 8:00 a.m. until 2 p.m.;
- The southbound off-ramp from SR-99 to Mariposa Road will close beginning Wednesday, October 10, 2012, through Thursday, October 11, 2012, from 8:00 a.m. until 2 p.m.;
- The southbound on and off-ramps on SR-99 at SR-4/ Farmington Road will close on Tuesday, October 9, 2012, from 8:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.;
- The #2 (right) lane on southbound SR-99 from SR-4/ Farmington Road to Mormon Slough/ past Golden Gate will close on Tuesday, October 9, 2012, from 8:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.
