TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 132 IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

San Joaquin County - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform slab replacement on State Route 132 (SR-132) from the Stanislaus/ San Joaquin County line to Interstate 5 (I-5).

Work will occur as follows:

- Crews will perform one-way traffic control on SR-132 from the Stanislaus/ San Joaquin County line to Koster Road beginning Sunday, October 7, 2012, through Friday, October 12, 2012, from 8:00 p.m. until 4:00 a.m.;
- The on and off-ramps from SR-132 to Chrisman Road will close beginning Thursday, October 11, 2012, through Friday, October 12, 2012, from 8:00 p.m. until 4:00 a.m.;
- The off-ramp from eastbound SR-132 to I-5 will close beginning Sunday, October 7, 2012, through Monday, October 8, 2012, from 8:00 p.m. until 4:00 a.m.;
- The on and off-ramps from westbound SR-132 to I-5 will close beginning Monday, October 8, 2012, through Tuesday, October 9, 2012, from 8:00 p.m. until 4:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 15 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials and construction related issues.
