### TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 IN STANISLAUS COUNTY

**Stanislaus County** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform highway construction and work on the traffic signals on State Route 99 (SR-99) from Taylor Road to Hammett Road. Work will occur at the following locations:

- The #2 (center) and #3 (right) lanes and right shoulder on SR-99 from Taylor Road to Hatch Road will close beginning Monday, September 24, 2012, through Saturday, September 29, 2012, from 7:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.;
- Various on and off-ramps on SR-99 at Taylor Road will close beginning Monday, September 24, 2012, through Saturday, September 29, 2012, from 6:00 p.m. until 10:00 a.m.;
- Various on and off-ramps on SR-99 at Whitmore Avenue will close beginning Monday, September 24, 2012, through Saturday, September 29, 2012, from 7:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.;
- The #2 (center) and #3 (right) lanes and right shoulder on SR-99 from Hatch Road to the Stanislaus/ San Joaquin County line will close beginning Monday, September 24, 2012, through Saturday, September 29, 2012, from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;

- The southbound off-ramp on SR-99 at Carpenter Road/ Briggsmore will close beginning Monday, September 24, 2012, through Wednesday, September 26, 2012, from 11:00 p.m. until 4:00 a.m.;
- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps on SR-99 at Hammett Road will close beginning Monday, September 24, 2012, through Saturday, September 29, 2012, from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 30 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken when possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials and construction related issues.
