TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 IN STANISLAUS COUNTY

Stanislaus County - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform highway construction, grinding, paving, electrical work and work on the bridges on State Route 99 (SR-99) from the Stanislaus/ Merced County line to the Stanislaus/ San Joaquin County line.

- The northbound off-ramp from SR-99 to Mitchell Road will close on Monday, October 1, 2012, from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.;
- The on and off-ramps from SR-99 to Crows Landing Road will close beginning Tuesday, October 2, 2012, through Thursday, October 4, 2012, from 8:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.;
- The #3 (right) lane and right shoulder on southbound SR-99 from 5th Street/ G Street to 5th Street/ H Street will close on Wednesday, October 3, 2012, from 6:00 p.m. until 2:00 p.m.;
- The northbound on-ramp on from SR-99 to Kansas Avenue will close on Thursday, October 4, 2012, from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.;
- The #3 (right) lane and right shoulder on northbound SR-99 at Broadway Avenue/ SR-99 will close on Friday, October 5, 2012, from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.

- The on and off-ramps on SR-99 from the Merced County line to the San Joaquin County line will alternately close beginning Monday, October 1, 2012, through Saturday, October 6, 2012, from 7:00 p.m. until 10:00 a.m.;
- The lanes and shoulders on SR-99 from the Merced County line to the San Joaquin County line will alternately close beginning Monday, October 1, 2012, through Saturday, October 6, 2012, from 7:00 p.m. until 10:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 30 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials and construction related issues.
