### **TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM STATE ROUTE 120/YOSEMITE AVENUE TO MARIPOSA ROAD IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY**

**San Joaquin County** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform highway construction and excavation on State Route 99 (SR-99) from SR-120/Yosemite Avenue to Mariposa Road. Work will occur as follows:

- The # 1 (left) lane, median and left shoulder on SR-99 from SR-120/Yosemite Avenue to Arch Road will close beginning Sunday, April 21, 2013, through Friday, April 26, 2013, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound off-ramp from SR-99 to North Manteca/Main Street will close beginning Sunday, April 21, 2013, through Friday, April 26, 2013, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound on-ramp from Mariposa Road to SR-99 will close beginning Monday, April 22, 2013, through Wednesday, April 24, 2013, from 10:00 p.m. until 4:00 a.m.;
- The on and off-ramps from SR-99 to SR-4/Farmington Road will close beginning Monday, April 22, 2013, through Wednesday, April 24, 2013, from 10:00 p.m. until 4:00 a.m.;
- The southbound on-ramp from Charter Way to SR-99 will close beginning Monday, April 22, 2013, through Wednesday, April 24, 2013, from 10:00 p.m. until 4:00 a.m.;

- Southbound SR-99 from SR-4/Crosstown to Mariposa Road will close beginning Monday, April 22, 2013, through Wednesday, April 24, 2013, from 10:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The # 2 (right) lane on SR-99 from SR-4 (Crosstown) to Mariposa Road will close beginning Wednesday, April 24, 2013, through Friday, April 26, 2013, from 10:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;

Motorists should expect 15 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials and construction related issues.
