TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 IN STANISLAUS COUNTY

Stanislaus County - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform highway construction on State Route 99 (SR-99) from Taylor Road to the Stanislaus/San Joaquin County line. Work will occur at the following locations:

- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps on SR-99 from Taylor Road to Hammett Road will alternately close beginning Sunday, May 12, 2013, through Saturday, May 18, 2013, from 7:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.;
- The #2 (center) and #3 (right) lanes and right shoulder on northbound and southbound SR-99 from Taylor Road to the Stanislaus/San Joaquin County line will close beginning Sunday, May 12, 2013, through Saturday, May 18, 2013, from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 30 minute delays.

Crews will also intermittently close northbound and southbound off-ramps from SR-99 to SR-219/Kiernan Avenue beginning Sunday, May 12, 2013, through Friday, May 17, 2013, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m. Motorists should expect 10 minute delays.

Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials and construction related issues.
