### TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM MARIPOSA ROAD TO STATE ROUTE 4/CROSSTOWN FREEWAY IN STOCKTON

**Stockton** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform highway construction on State Route 99 (SR-99) from Mariposa Road to State Route 4(SR-4)/ Crosstown Freeway. No two consecutive ramps will close at the same time. Work will occur as follows:

- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps will alternately close beginning Monday, November 18, 2013, through Friday, November 22, 2013, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.
- The northbound #1(left) and #2 (right) lanes will alternately close beginning Monday, November 18, 2013, through Friday, November 22, 2013, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.
- The southbound #1(left) and #2 (right) lanes will alternately close beginning Monday, November 18, 2013, through Friday, November 22, 2013, from 10:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 10 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials and construction related issues.
