TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM 5TH STREET TO STATE ROUTE 132/MAZE BOULEVARD IN STANISLAUS COUNTY

Stanislaus County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform highway construction on State Route 99 (SR-99) from 5th Street/G Street to SR-132 (Maze Boulevard/L Street). No two consecutive ramps will be closed at one time. Work will occur at the following locations:

- The on and off-ramps on northbound and southbound SR-99 from 5th Street/G Street to SR-132/Maze Boulevard will alternately close beginning Sunday, October 6, 2013, through Friday, October 11, 2013, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The #1(left), #2 (left center), #3 (right center) and #4 (right) lanes on SR-99 from 5th Street to SR-132/Maze Boulevard will alternately close beginning Sunday, October 6, 2013, through Friday, October 11, 2013, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 15 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials, and construction related issues.
