TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 108 FROM STANDARD ROAD/MONO WAY TO DRAPER MINE ROAD IN TUOLUMNE COUNTY

Tuolumne County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform one-way traffic control on State Route 108 (SR-108) from Standard Road/Mono Way to Draper Mine Road for construction activities.

Crews will begin work on Sunday, October 20, 2013, through Friday, October 25, 2013, from 7:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m.

Motorists should expect 15 minute delays.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/ or materials and construction related issues.

The construction is part of the \$54.5 million SR-108 East Sonora Bypass Stage II Project which began on April 19, 2012. The project will construct a two-lane expressway on a new alignment from Peaceful Oak Road to Via Este Road. A partial interchange at Peaceful Oak Road, a grade separation at Mono Way and a temporary at-grade "T" intersection connecting Mono Way to the new expressway will also be built. In addition, a frontage road connecting existing SR-108 with both Seaborn Road and Waif Road will be constructed. This project received \$14.53 million from Proposition 1B, the \$19.9 billion transportation bond approved by voters in 2006.
