### **TRAFFIC ADVISORY SOUTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 99 FROM STATE ROUTE 4/CROSTOWN FREEWAY TO ARCH ROAD IN STOCKTON**

**Stockton** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will alternately close the on and off-ramps on southbound State Route 99 (SR-99) from SR-4/Crosstown Freeway to Arch Road for highway construction. No two consecutive ramps will close at the same time.

Work will begin Monday, April 7, 2014, through Friday, April 11, 2014, from 10:00 p.m. until 5 a.m.

Motorists should expect 10 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials, and construction related issues.
