### **TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM THE MILES CREEK BRIDGE TO COLLIER ROAD IN MERCED COUNTY**

**Merced County** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform landscaping and various road construction activities on State Route 99 (SR-99) from the Miles Creek Bridge to Collier Road. Work will occur as follows:

- The #1 (left) lane and left shoulder on southbound SR-99 from the Miles Creek Bridge to the Duck Slough Bridge will close beginning Tuesday, April 29, 2014, through Wednesday, April 30, 2014, from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.;
- The northbound and southbound on-ramp from Collier Road to SR-99 will close beginning Tuesday, April 29, 2014, through Wednesday, April 30, 2014, from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.;
- The northbound on-ramp from SR-140 (near 15<sup>th</sup> Street) to SR-99 is closed and scheduled to reopen May of 2014;
- The northbound off-ramp from SR-99 to SR-140 (near 16<sup>th</sup> Street) is closed and scheduled to reopen May of 2014;
- The southbound on-ramp from G Street to SR-99 is closed and scheduled to reopen May of 2014;
- The northbound off-ramp from SR-99 to G Street is closed and scheduled to reopen May of 2014;
- The eastbound connector ramp from SR-140 to SR-99/ near 17<sup>th</sup> Street (Main Street) is closed and scheduled to reopen May of 2014.

Motorists should expect 15 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.
