TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM STANISLAUS/SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY LINE TO ARCH ROAD IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

San Joaquin County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform various road construction and maintenance activities on State Route 99 (SR-99) from Stanislaus/San Joaquin County Line to Arch Road. No two consecutive ramps will close at the same time. Work will occur as follows:

- The lanes on northbound and southbound SR-99 from the Stanislaus/San Joaquin County Line to Arch Road will alternately close beginning Sunday, August 17, 2014, through Friday, August 22, 2014, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:30 a.m.;
- The southbound off-ramp from SR-99 to Austin Road will close beginning Monday, August 18, 2014, through Friday, August 22, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The southbound off-ramp from SR-99 to Main Street in Manteca will close beginning Sunday, August 17, 2014, through Friday, August 22, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The on and off-ramps on northbound and southbound SR-99 at Lathrop Road will alternately close beginning Sunday, August 17, 2014, through Friday, August 22, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- French Camp Road under SR-99 will close beginning Sunday, August 17, 2014 through Wednesday, August 20, 2014 from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.
- The northbound off-ramp from SR-99 to French Camp Road is closed and scheduled to reopen spring 2015;
- The #1 (left) and #2 (right) lanes on northbound and southbound SR-99 from Arch Road to SR-4/Crosstown Freeway will alternately close beginning Sunday, August 17, 2014, through Friday, August 22, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;

- The on and off-ramps on northbound and southbound SR-99 from Mariposa Road to Main Street in Stockton will alternately close beginning Sunday, August 17, 2014, through Friday, August 22, 2014, from 9:00 p.m. until 4:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 15 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials, and construction related issues.
