TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM STATE ROUTE 140 TO SHANKS ROAD IN MERCED COUNTY

Merced County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform various road construction and bridge activities on State Route 99 (SR-99) from SR-140 to Shanks Road. Work will occur as follows:

- The northbound on-ramp from Atwater Boulevard to SR-99 will close on Monday, June 16, 2014, from 9:00 a.m. until 2:30 p.m.;
- The northbound on and off-ramps from SR-99 to Hammatt Avenue will alternately close on Tuesday, June 17, 2014, from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.;
- The northbound on and off-ramps from SR-99 to Winton Parkway will alternately close on Wednesday, June 18, 2014, from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.;
- The northbound on and off-ramps from SR-99 to Shanks Road will alternately close on Thursday, June 19, 2014, from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.;
- The southbound off-ramp from SR-99 to Winton Parkway will close on Friday, June 20, 2014, from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. (noon);
- The southbound on-ramp from Collier Road to SR-99 will close on Friday, June 20, 2014, from 12:30 p.m. until 1:00 p.m.;
- The northbound on-ramp from SR-140 (near 15th Street) to SR-99 is closed and scheduled to reopen November of 2014;
- The northbound off-ramp from SR-99 to SR-140 (near 16th Street) is closed and scheduled to reopen November of 2014;

- The southbound on-ramp from G Street to SR-99 is closed and scheduled to reopen November of 2014;
- The northbound off-ramp from SR-99 to G Street is closed and scheduled to reopen November of 2014;
- The eastbound connector ramp from SR-140 to SR-99 (near 17th Street/Main Street) is closed and scheduled to reopen November of 2014.

Motorists should expect 5 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

Construction is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/ or materials, and construction related issues.
