TRAFFIC ADVISORY INTERSTATE 5 FROM STANISLAUS/SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY LINE TO COUNTRY CLUB BOULEVARD IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

San Joaquin County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform various road construction and bridge activities on Interstate 5 (I-5) from the Stanislaus/San Joaquin County line to Country Club Boulevard. Work will occur as follows:

- The #1 (left) and #2 (right) lanes on northbound and southbound I-5 from the Stanislaus/San Joaquin County line to Tom Paine Slough will alternately close beginning Sunday, August 2, 2015, through Friday, August 7, 2015, from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The northbound and southbound connector ramps from I-5 to State Route 33 (SR-33) will close beginning Sunday, August 2, 2015, through Friday, August 7, 2015, from 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The southbound off-ramp from I-5 to 11th Street will close from Sunday, August 2, 2015, through Friday, August 7, 2015, from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The northbound on-ramp from 11th Street to I-5 will close from Sunday, August 2, 2015, through Friday, August 7, 2015, from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The #1(left) #2 (middle) and #3 (right) lanes on northbound and southbound I-5 from SR-4/Charter Way to Country Club Boulevard will alternately close from Sunday, August 2, 2015, through Friday, August 7, 2015, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The connector ramps from northbound and southbound I-5 to the eastbound SR-4/Crosstown Freeway will alternately close Sunday, August 2, 2015, through Friday, August 7, 2015, from 10:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;

- The northbound and southbound on and off ramps on I-5 from SR-4/Charter Way to Country Club Boulevard will alternately close from Sunday, August 2, 2015, through Friday, August 7, 2015, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 10 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.
