TRAFFIC ADVISORY INTERSTATE 5 FROM STANISLAUS/MERCED COUNTY LINE TO TOM PAINE SLOUGH IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

Stanislaus/San Joaquin County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will be performing pavement work on Interstate 5 from the Stanislaus/Merced County line to Tom Paine Slough in San Joaquin County. **(Due to the Holiday, there will be no scheduled construction from Thursday afternoon, December 24, 2015, through Sunday evening, December 27, 2015.)**

Work is scheduled to begin Sunday, December 20, 2015, through Wednesday, December 23, 2015, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 10 minute delays and seek alternate routes.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/ or materials and construction related issues.

This is part of the Interstate 5 Repaving and Rehabilitation Project, a \$51 million effort that will repave 40 miles of I-5 in Merced, Stanislaus and San Joaquin counties. Work began in April 2015 and is scheduled to finish in April 2016. The project extends from Tom Paine Slough in San Joaquin County, just north of the I-205 interchange, to just south of the Merced/Stanislaus County line. The project also is installing in-ground detections loops and paving on and off-ramps so they conform smoothly with local roads.
