TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM STATE ROUTE 120/YOSEMITE AVENUE TO THE SAN JOAQUIN/SACRAMENTO COUNTY LINE

San Joaquin County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform various road construction and maintenance activities on State Route 99 (SR-99) from SR-120/Yosemite Avenue to the San Joaquin/Sacramento County line. No two consecutive ramps will close at the same time. Work will occur as follows:

- The #1 (left) and #2 (right) lanes, left, right shoulder, and median on northbound and southbound SR-99 from SR-120/Yosemite Avenue to Arch Road will alternately close beginning Sunday, June 7, 2015, through Friday, June 12, 2015, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps on SR-99 from Lathrop Road to French Camp Road will alternately close beginning Sunday, June 7, 2015, through Friday, June 12, 2015, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound and southbound off-ramps, the northbound on-ramp and the overcrossing at Mariposa Road are closed and scheduled to reopen summer 2016;
- The northbound on-ramps from SR-26/Fremont Street through Cherokee Lane to SR-99 will close beginning Sunday, June 7, 2015, through Friday, June 12, 2015, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps on SR-99 from Hammer Lane to the San Joaquin/Sacramento County Line will alternately close beginning Sunday, June 7, 2015, through Friday, June 12, 2015, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left) and #2 (right) lanes on northbound and southbound SR-99 from Cherokee Lane to the San Joaquin/Sacramento County line will alternately close beginning Sunday, June 7, 2015, through Friday, June 12, 2015, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.
