TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM MISSION AVENUE TO BEAR CREEK BRIDGE IN MERCED COUNTY

Merced County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform various road construction and bridge activities on State Route 99 (SR-99) from Mission Avenue to Bear Creek Bridge. Work will occur as follows:

- The southbound off-ramp from SR-99 to Mission Avenue will close beginning Monday, November 2, 2015, through Tuesday, November 3, 2015, from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.;
- The southbound off-ramp from SR-99 to SR-140 (south of Bear Creek Bridge) will close Wednesday, November 4, 2015, from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.;
- The northbound off-ramp from SR-99 to R Street will close on Thursday, November 5, 2015, from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.;
- The southbound off-ramp from SR-99 (near 16th Street) to eastbound SR-140 is closed and scheduled to reopen spring of 2016;
- The southbound on-ramp from G Street to SR-99 is closed and scheduled to reopen spring of 2016;
- The connector ramp from southbound SR-99/near 17th Street (Main Street) to eastbound SR-140 is closed and scheduled to reopen December of 2015.

Motorists should expect 15 minute delays. A signed detour is in place and alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

Work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/ or materials, and construction related issues.
