TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 88 FROM SOUTH STATE ROUTE 49 IN JACKSON TO FOSTER MEADOW ROAD IN AMADOR COUNTY

Amador County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will be performing one-way traffic control on eastbound and westbound State Route 88 (SR-88) from Cat Creek Road to Foster Meadow Road in Amador County for grinding and paving operations.

Work is scheduled to begin Sunday, June 26, 2016, through Friday, July 1, 2016, from 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.

One way traffic control will also occur on eastbound and westbound SR-88 from South SR-49 in Jackson to Shake Ridge Road for tree work beginning Monday, June 27, 2016, through Friday, July 1, 2016, from 8:00 a.m. until 2:30 p.m.

One way traffic control will also be performed on eastbound SR-88 from Wagon Wheel Drive to Silver Drive (left)/Golf Links Drive (right) for grinding operations on Monday, June 27, 2016 from 9:00 a.m. until Noon.

Motorists should expect 10 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

Work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials and construction related issues.
