CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY CALTRANS INSTALLING RUMBLE STRIPS ON STATE ROUTE 49 IN CALAVERAS COUNTY

Calaveras County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is preparing to begin work on a project that will install rumble strips in the median and outside shoulders on State Route 49 (SR-49). Work will occur as follows:

- Just north of the Tuolumne/Calaveras County line to just south of Frogtown Road in Calaveras County, a distance of 5 miles.
- Just north of Copello Drive to Airport Road, a distance of 9 miles.
- Pool Station Road to the Calaveras/Amador County line, a distance of 10.6 miles.

Work is scheduled to begin May 9, 2016, and be completed in July 2016.

Rumble strips are designed to alert drivers when their vehicles leave their traffic lane. As tires pass over the rumble strips, drivers can hear the noise and feel the vibration produced by these rumble strips. These strips are ground into the pavement surface.

One-way traffic control will be used and drivers should expect 10-minute delays. The majority of work will be performed from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.

This \$823,000 project has been awarded to Chrisp Company.

Work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials and construction related issues.
