TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 152 FROM THE SANTA CLARA/ MERCED COUNTY LINE TO UPPER COTTON WOOD ROAD IN MERCED COUNTY

Merced County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will alternately close the median, left and right shoulders, and the #1 (left) and #2 (right) lanes on State Route 152 (SR-152) from the Santa Clara/ Merced County line to Upper Cotton Wood Road for paving.

Work will begin on Monday, May 9, 2016, through Friday, May 13, 2016, from 5:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.

Motorists should expect 10 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

Construction is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/ or materials, and construction related issues.

This work is part of the \$7.5 million SR-152 Pacheco Pass Median Project which began on May 2, 2016. Crews will install a concrete median barrier on the left shoulder, widen the left shoulder, and install a permanent Changeable Message Sign (CMS) with detector loops, a Closed Circuit Television (CCTV), a Roadside Weather Information System and count station.

REMINDER: During the construction project, the speed limit on SR-152 from the Santa Clara/ Merced County line to Vista Point/ Access Road has been reduced from 65 M.P.H to **55 M.P.H.**

Construction is scheduled to be completed by the end of August 2016.
