**54-HOUR FULL CLOSURE**  
**STATE ROUTE 99 CONNECTOR RAMP TO STATE ROUTE 4/ CROSTOWN**  
**FREEWAY**  
**IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY**

**San Joaquin County** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close the westbound connector ramp from State Route 99 (SR-99) to SR-4/Crosstown Freeway for highway construction.

Work is scheduled to begin Friday, May 20, 2016, at 10:00 p.m. through Monday, May 23, 2016, at 5:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 10 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/ or materials and construction related issues.

This work is part of the Crosstown Big Fix project which will include eight 55-hour various weekend closures between April 29 – October 24. One direction per weekend of the Crosstown Freeway will be closed at a time for rehabilitation. Weekend closures will save 50 working days of construction and reduce lane closures from 140 days to 15 days. I-5 and SR-99 traffic will be redirected to detours and alternate routes at SR-120 and SR-12.
