## **TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 4/CROSTOWN FREEWAY FROM INTERSTATE 5 TO STATE ROUTE 99**

**San Joaquin County** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform various road construction activities on State Route 4(SR-4)/Crosstown Freeway from Interstate 5 to SR-99.

- The #1 (left) and #2 (middle) lanes on eastbound and westbound SR-4/Crosstown Freeway from Airport Way to SR-99 will close beginning Sunday, September 18, 2016, through Friday, September 23, 2016, from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The on and off-ramps on eastbound SR-4/Crosstown Freeway from Stanislaus Street to Wilson Way will close beginning Sunday, September 18, 2016, through Friday, September 23, 2016, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.
- The eastbound and westbound on and off-ramps on SR-4/Crosstown Freeway from Wilson Way to Filbert Street will close beginning Sunday, September 18, 2016, through Friday, September 23, 2016, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;

Motorists should expect 10 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/ or materials and construction related issues.
