




Notice of Availability

of the Final Environmental Document for the Mira Mesa /Scripps Ranch Direct Access Ramp Project

WHAT'S BEING PLANNED? The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in cooperation with the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) is proposing a direct access ramp to connect local street traffic in Mira Mesa to the express lanes on Interstate 15.



WHY THIS NOTICE? Caltrans has prepared a Final Environmental Impact Report / Environmental Assessment (FEIR/EA) in compliance with both the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) to analyze potential effects the proposed project alternatives may have on the environment. This notice is to inform you of Caltrans' approval of the FEIR/EA.

WHAT'S AVAILABLE? The FEIR/EA which describes the project is now available to the public for review.
