



UPDATE:

**Interstate 5 Ocean View Rehab Project --
No Work Planned For Thanksgiving Holiday Weekend**

Construction crews are working on a major pavement improvement project on Interstate 5 (I-5), between Oceanside and the San Diego County-Orange County line. The Ocean View Rehab Project closes three of four lanes on northbound and southbound I-5 in about two-mile sections nightly, including some weekends, from 7:30 p.m.-5 a.m.

There will be no construction during the Thanksgiving Holiday Weekend, starting Wednesday, Nov. 26 at 5 a.m. Work will resume on Tuesday, Dec. 2 at 7:30 p.m. Motorist should anticipate traffic delays during these work hours. The project as a whole is expected to take about two years to complete.

This work is not connected to the I-5 North Coast Corridor Project. No additional lanes will be added at the conclusion of this pavement improvement project.
