



# NOTICE OF OPEN HOUSE PUBLIC SCOPING MEETING

## for State Route 94 Improvement Project

**WHAT'S BEING PLANNED?** Caltrans will be the lead agency for a project considering potential alternatives for improvements to various locations along State Route 94 (SR-94) in and around Jamul, California. The improvements are proposed by the Jamul Indian Village (JIV) to mitigate significant traffic impacts of the gaming facility approved by the JIV. Each design alternative considered would include a proposed access road improvement together with improvements to select intersections along SR-94. In addition to the design alternatives, a No Project Alternative will also be addressed. The improvements for the proposed access road would include the access road itself as well as improvements to SR-94 extending from a location north of Melody Road southward to an area south of the Jamul Reservation. The access road improvements would include signalization and upgrade of the Melody Road/SR-94 intersection, regardless of the access road option selected. The other intersection improvements would occur at the following locations: (1) SR-94/Jamacha Boulevard, (2) SR-94/Jamacha Road, (3) SR-94/Steele Canyon Road, (4) SR-94/Lyons Valley Road, (5) SR-94/Maxfield Road, and (6) SR-94/Melody Road.

**WHY THIS AD?** Caltrans has initiated the required environmental documentation process and will prepare an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) to analyze potential impacts along the corridor. This notice is to inform you of the scheduled public scoping meeting for this project. The scoping meeting will provide you with an opportunity to review and discuss the proposed alternatives and to provide comments on the scope of environmental issues to be studied in the EIR.

**ABOUT THE PUBLIC SCOPING MEETING:** Caltrans will be hosting an open house style scoping meeting. You may attend the meeting anytime between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m., as there will be no formal presentation. The public will have the opportunity to speak directly with Caltrans representatives about the project and its potential impacts. Meeting attendees will have the opportunity to review project fact sheets, display boards and other project information.

**WHERE YOU COME IN:** A court reporter will be available at the scoping meeting to take your comments, or comments may be submitted at the meeting by completing a written comment form.
