This letter to confirm water availability for the above referenced subject project, Caltrans state job see Caltrans' map. Its location is within the City of San Diego water service area. This location will have potable water facilities for this project's use in the existing fronting City streets, at existing fire hydrants see City water maps. The existing water facilities that serve this area are complete.

The City of San Diego will be able to provide adequate potable water through the existing potable water facilities for this construction project at this time. On April 21, 1991 the San Diego City Council instituted a 20 percent water conservation goal. This goal remains in effect today, since San Diego imports 90 percent of its water. San Diego's water customers are encouraged to use water efficiently and not to waste it or use it unreasonably.

Water service connections are available. These connections are requested per required demand. All services are governed by City ordinances and regulations concerning connections, construction, capacity charges, permit fees and matters pertaining thereto.
