Dear Mr. Diaz

This letter will confirm that water will be available for the construction of Imperial 7 Expressway project, from Route 98 to Interstate 8 (I-8), in Imperial County.

The procedure for obtaining water is as follows:

Contractor must fill out an "Application For Temporary Water Use" at:

Southwest Division Office
2151 W. Adams Avenue
El Centro, CA 92243

or

Holtville Division Office
567 Pine Avenue
Holtville, CA 92250

1. Contractor will indicate the locations where they would like to obtain water. The Division Superintendent must approve location of the pump.
2. Contractor will be responsible for pump installation and removal.
3. Pump sites must be maintained in such a condition to allow unrestricted traffic flow on roadway.
4. Routine canal cutouts for three or six day periods may be scheduled during temporary service.
5. IID reserves the right to deny service if it will adversely effect operation and maintenance of the canal system.
6. The Division Office must be notified when a pump is removed.

An "Application For Temporary Water Use" permit will be required for each individual pump used. The permit is valid for a maximum of one year. A new permit must be signed each successive year. As indicated in your letter an amount of approximately 300,000 cubic meters of water will be needed from October 2003 to December 2005. Once the permit is approved, IID will guarantee that contractors have sufficient water for the construction of the Imperial 7 Expressway project.
