Construct Managed Lane (Middle Segment-Unit 1)

This letter is to confirm the water availability for the above referenced subject project. Its location is within the City of San Diego water service area. This location will have water facilities for this project, in the fronting City streets (City Fire Hydrants). The existing water facilities that serve this area are complete.

The City of San Diego will be able to provide adequate potable water through the existing water facilities for this construction project at this time. On April 21, 1991, the San Diego City Council instituted a 20 percent water conservation goal. This goal remains in effect today, since San Diego imports 90 percent of its water. San Diego's water customers are encouraged to use water efficiently and not to waste it or use it unreasonably.

Water service connections are available. These connections are requested per required demand: 190,000 gallons over approximately 42 months. All services are governed by City ordinances and regulations concerning connections, construction, capacity charges, permit fees and matters pertaining thereto.
