FACT SHEET

GOALS

- Relieve existing and future traffic congestion on off-ramp
- Improve traffic operation from highway to city street
- Provide additional safety enhancements

CONTACT

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THE PROJECT

Construction began in late 2009 on safety improvements at the off-ramp from southbound State Route 94 to westbound College Avenue in the city of Lemon Grove. Traffic signals will be installed at the end of the ramp/intersection. In addition, the ramp will be widened from midway down the ramp to the intersection to make room for another turn lane. Other improvements will add concrete barrier and retaining wall.

FUNDING

The project cost is about \$2.4 million. The funds are programmed as part of the State Highway Operations and Protection Plan (SHOPP).

TRAFFIC

This work is expected to help improve the flow of vehicles, reduce traffic congestion and subsequently reduce the number of collisions. The average number of vehicles using the off-ramp each day has steadily increased during the past decade. It is projected to increase 40 percent to almost 9,000 vehicles a day by the year 2030.

STATUS

This project is being constructed and expected to be opened to traffic this summer.
