




PUBLIC NOTICE

Notice of Availability of the Draft Environmental Document & Public Hearing STATE ROUTE 905 (From I-805 to the Otay Mesa Port of Entry)



WHAT'S BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is proposing to construct a new six-lane highway from the Otay Mesa Port of Entry at the U.S./Mexico Border to Interstate 805 in San Diego County. The project will include interchanges with local streets and a freeway interchange at proposed State Route 125.

WHY THIS AD?

Caltrans has studied the effects the project alternatives may have on the environment. Our studies show that the project could significantly affect the quality of the environment. A Draft Environmental Impact Statement / Environmental Impact Report (EIS/EIR) which discusses potential project impacts has been prepared. This notice is to inform you of the Draft EIS/EIR and its availability for review, and a scheduled public hearing. The public hearing is to give you an opportunity to review and discuss proposed project features and the results of environmental studies before a final route alignment alternative is selected. The proposed project could impact up to 0.15 hectares (0.36 acres) of ACOE jurisdictional wetlands.

ABOUT THE PUBLIC HEARING:

There will be no formal presentation. This will be an "Open Forum" hearing where you will have the opportunity to speak directly with Caltrans representatives about the project and its environmental impacts. A Certified Court Reporter will be available to take your comments for the record, or you may make them in writing, if preferred. All substantive comments will be addressed in the Final Environmental Document.

WHAT'S AVAILABLE?

The Draft EIS/EIR which describes the project is now available to the public for review at the following locations: City of San Diego – Central Library, 820 E Street, San Diego; Otay Mesa – San Diego Branch Library, 3003 Coronado Avenue, San Diego; San Ysidro – San Diego Branch Library, 101 West San Ysidro Boulevard, San Diego; South Chula Vista Library, 389 Orange Avenue, Chula Vista; Caltrans District 11 in Old Town, 2829 Juan Street, San Diego.

Project maps/plans, the Draft EIS/EIR, technical reports, and other project information are also available for review and copying at the Caltrans District Office located at 2829 Juan Street, San Diego on weekdays, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. To obtain a copy of the Draft EIS/EIR, telephone or write to Greg Gastelum, Caltrans, P.O. Have the potential impacts been addressed? Do you have information that should be included? Do you agree with the findings? Your comments will be part of the public records. If there are no major concerns or comments on the project, Caltrans will request approval from the Federal Highway Administration and proceed with the final project design.
