
On behalf of the interested parties, LSA Associates, Inc. (LSA) is formally requesting United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) concurrence with and acceptance of the Jurisdictional Delineation for the proposed project (attached). Please respond to this request in writing at your earliest convenience.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) Districts 8 and 12, in conjunction with the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) and the Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC), propose to add an additional general-purpose lane and widen all lanes and shoulders to standard widths on eastbound State Route 91 (SR-91), to the south, between State Route 241 (SR-241) in eastern Orange County and State Route 71 (SR-71) in western Riverside County. The purpose of the project is to reduce traffic congestion, improve operational deficiencies, and comply with legislative requirements on eastbound SR-91 between SR-241 and SR-71, consistent with Caltrans design standards.
