**SR-91 Eastbound Lane Addition Project
Between SR-241 and SR-71
KP 25.6/32.0 (PM 15.9/19.9) and KP 0.0/4.7 (PM 0.0/2.9)**

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has determined that the Build Alternative (Alternative 2) will have no significant impact on the human environment. Alternative 2 proposes to add an additional general-purpose lane and widen all lanes and shoulders to standard widths on eastbound State Route 91 (SR-91) to the south between State Route 241 (SR-241) in eastern Orange County and State Route 71 (SR-71) in western Riverside County.

This Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) is based on the attached Environmental Assessment (EA) and the associated Technical Studies, which have been independently evaluated by Caltrans and determined to adequately and accurately discuss the need, environmental issues, and impacts of the proposed project and appropriate mitigation measures. It provides sufficient evidence and analysis for determining that an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is not required. Caltrans takes full responsibility for the accuracy, scope, and content of the attached EA and associated Technical Studies.
