

Extension of Public Comment Period for Draft Environmental Impact Report, State Route 74



WHAT'S BEING PLANNED

CALTRANS (California Department of Transportation) is proposing to widen State Route 74 (SR-74) from two lanes to four lanes from Calle Entradero in the City of San Juan Capistrano to the City/Orange County line.

WHY THIS AD

CALTRANS has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show it will not significantly affect the quality of the project location for most environmental concerns. The report that explains why is called an Environmental Impact Report. **This notice is to inform you of the availability of the Draft Environmental Impact Report and the extension of the public comment period to February 14, 2009.**
