



The Orangeman Triathlon is taking place on September 23rd, 2012. This USA Triathlon sanctioned event consists of a 1.2 mile swim, 56 mile bike ride and 13.1 mile run. The swim takes place in the ocean at Doheny State Beach in Dana Point, the bike ride utilizes Ortega Highway from Avenida Siega (just west of Antonio Parkway) in San Juan Capistrano to El Cariso Village; and, a 13.1 mile run along the coast in Dana Point.

Ortega Highway will be closed on Sunday, September 23, 2012 as follows:

1. Westbound Ortega Highway will be closed from 6:30AM to 12:30 PM from El Cariso Village, in front of Hell's Kitchen, to Antonio Parkway.
2. Eastbound Ortega Highway will be closed from 7:00AM to 12:30PM from Antonio Parkway to El Cariso Village, in front of Hell's Kitchen.

Traffic Alert – Riverside County

- Alternate Routes for Riverside County Residents and for the General travelling Public as follows:
 - For North Orange County Cities: Interstate 15 North to 91 Fwy Westbound (towards Beach Cities)
 - For South Orange County Cities: Interstate 15 South to Hwy 76 Westbound (towards Oceanside), Interstate 5 North
- Access - Although the Ortega Highway will be closed as indicated above, access will be allowed for residents! We encourage local residents to plan accordingly and to not use the highway unless an emergency situation arises
- Race Participants – Have been made aware that access may occur and that law enforcement, emergency vehicles and residents who may need to leave may enter the roadway. Athletes will follow normal traffic laws and stay to the right side of the road.
- Portable message signs (electronic) will be posted 10 days in advance on Interstate 15, at streets or intersections that will be impacted to notify the public of the upcoming event.

Traffic Alert – Orange County

- Alternate Routes for Orange County Residents and for the General travelling Public as follows:
 - For North Riverside County Cities: Interstate 5 North, 55 Fwy North, and 91 Fwy Eastbound (towards Riverside)
 - For South Riverside County Cities: Interstate 5 South, Hwy 76 Eastbound (towards Escondido), Interstate 15 North
- Ortega Highway – Avenida Siega to Antonio Pkwy [South lane(s) closed] – 7:00am – 12:30pm
- Ortega Highway – Antonio Parkway to El Cariso Village (eastbound): 7:00am – 12:30pm
- Ortega Highway – El Cariso Village to Antonio Pkwy (westbound): 6:30am – 12:30pm
- Access - Although the Ortega Highway will be closed as indicated above, access will be allowed for residents! We encourage local residents to plan accordingly and to not use the highway unless an emergency situation arises
- Race Participants – Have been made aware that access may occur and that law enforcement, emergency vehicles and residents who may need to leave may enter the roadway. Athletes will follow normal traffic laws and stay to the right side of the road.
