REVISED: 21 Day Full Closure of West SR- 91 Tustin Avenue On-ramp SR-91 Lane Extension & Auxiliary Lane Reconstruction Project 02/22/16 - 03/14/16

Irvine – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close the westbound SR-91 Tustin Avenue On-ramp in Anaheim for 21 consecutive days and 6 hours to place temporary k-rail, traffic screen and crash cushion, and reconstruct the On-ramp. The westbound SR-91 shoulder widening and Maintenance Vehicle Pullout (MVP) will also be done behind k-rail. The original 16 day and 6 hour closure was impacted due to El Nino Weather conditions. Detours will be posted to alert motorists.
