### 55 HOUR CLOSURE OF INTERSTATE 5 NORTH BOUND OFFRAMP AT ALICIA PARKWAY EXTENDED UNTIL AUGUST 1<sup>ST</sup> AT 5:00 A.M.

**Irvine**—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has begun a interchange reconstruction and upgrade project at Alicia Parkway in the City of Mission Viejo that will require ramp closures at Alicia Parkway. Unforeseen conditions as well as a disabled concrete pump during concrete placement has required delaying the opening of the offramp beyond the additional 24 hour period and is now scheduled to open at 5:00 a.m. Wednesday morning August 1<sup>st</sup> 2012

This project proposes to reconstruct the Interchange by realigning the on and offramps as well as installation of a sign structure.
