FULL CLOSURE OF SOUTHBOUND I-5 OFF-RAMP AT CAMINO DE ESTRELLA

Irvine— The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will have Lane Closures on the Southbound I-5 from just South of the PCH Hwy 1 On-ramp to the Southbound I-5 mainline and I-5 Off-ramp at Camino De Estrella, Wednesday September 19th from 10:00 p.m. to 11:59 p.m. with the Off-ramp closure expanding from a lane closure to a full ramp closure from 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 a.m. September 20th at which time the closure will reduce from a full ramp closure back to lane closures until 6:00 a.m. when all lanes will open to traffic. These lane and ramp closures will be repeated Thursday evening September 20th through Friday morning September 21st, 2012

These closures are required for lane striping and repositioning of K-rail as part of the Camino de Estrella Bridge Widening Project

Recommended detour:

Continue southbound to Vista Hermosa, turn left; enter I-5 North to Camino De Estrella.
