CLOSURES OF STATE ROUTE 241 FROM ANTONIO PARKWAY TO SANTA MARGARITA PARKWAY OCTOBER 10, 2014 THROUGH OCTOBER 18, 2014

Irvine—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues a pavement overlay project along the northbound and southbound SR-241 from Rancho Santa Margarita to Irvine. Full closures are planned along the southbound On-ramps and mainline beginning Friday, October 10th through Saturday, October 18, 2014 late night to early morning hours. Detours will be posted to alert motorists. Consecutive ramps in the same direction of travel will not be closed.
