CLOSURE OF STATE ROUTE 57 ORANGEWOOD AND KATELLA AVENUE OFF-RAMPS

Irvine - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close the southbound SR-57 freeway at Orangewood Avenue and northbound SR-57 at Katella Avenue Off-ramps Saturday, June 14, 2014 from 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. for the commencement address of the University of California Irvine by the President of the United States, Barak Obama at the Angel Stadium of Anaheim.

Over 40,000 are expected to attend the commencement ceremony that begins at 11:00 a.m. If you must travel in this area on Saturday, please use an alternate route to avoid traffic delays.

Changeable message signs will be in place to alert motorists of the closures.
