## State Route 91 Lane Extension and Auxiliary Lane Reconstruction Week of March 24, 2014

**Irvine**—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in partnership with Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) will close freeway travel lanes along the Northbound SR-55 at the Westbound SR-91 Connector Tuesday, March 25<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, March 30<sup>th</sup> with nightly closures. Crews will begin electrical and striping work. Additional closures along the SR-91 to Tustin Avenue are listed below.

### Northbound State Route 55 at Westbound State Route 91

Sunday., March 30th	12:00 a.m. – 7:00 a.m.	Full closure North SR-55 at North Lincoln Ave/Santiago/Nohl Ranch-Including SR-91 Express Lanes Electrical Work

**Detour:** North SR-55 exit West Lincoln Avenue to Tustin Ave or North Glassell Street onto West SR-91

### State Route 91 to Tustin Avenue – Alternating lanes closed

Tues., March 25 – Wed., March 26	12:00 a.m. – 4:00 a.m.	West SR-91 Lakeview - Tustin Ave Tree Work
Sat., March 29	12:00 a.m. – 7:00 a.m.	East SR-91 Kraemer to Tustin Ave Electrical Work
Sat., March 29	12:00 a.m. – 7:00 a.m.	SR-55 to Tustin Ave – Electrical Work

**Detour:** Not needed – alternating lanes only

Changeable message signs will be in place to alert motorists of the closures.

Once complete, motorists traveling northbound on SR-55 to the westbound SR-91 connector will have an option to exit Tustin Avenue using the new exit only bypass lane north of the connector, or the general purpose lane.
