State Route 91 Westbound Lane Widening Project State Route 57 to Interstate 5 Week of March 10, 2014

Anaheim and Fullerton - Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) in partnership with the Department of Transportation (Caltrans), are adding a new, four-mile westbound general-purpose lane to State Route 91 between State Route 57 and Interstate 5.

Ongoing construction activities include ramp closures and lane reductions from West of Brookhurst Street to East of State College. Work Crews will begin striping operations on surface streets and Off-ramps along the project area. Detour signage will be posted for all ramp closures. Adjacent ramps servicing two consecutive local streets will not be closed simultaneously.

Full Surface Street Closure - SR-91 Westbound at North Euclid Street 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Detour: North Euclid Street - West La Palma Ave, North Brookhurst Street to East Orangethorpe Ave

Detour: South Euclid Street - East Orangethorpe Ave, South Harbor Blvd, West La Palma Ave

Full Closure – SR-91 Westbound Off-ramp at Euclid Street 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Detour: West SR-91 exit Brookhurst Street Off-ramp, North Brookhurst Street to East Orangethorpe Ave

Full Surface Street Closure - SR-91 Westbound at North/South Raymond Ave/East Street 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Detour: North Raymond Ave - West La Palma Ave, North Lemon Street, East Orangethorpe Ave

Detour: South Raymond Ave – East Orangethorpe Ave, South Acacia Street, West La Palma Ave

Full Surface Street Closure – SR-91 Westbound at North State College Blvd 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Detour: North State College Blvd- North Placentia Ave to West Orangethorpe Ave

Detour: South State College Blvd – East Orangethorpe Ave to South Placentia Ave
