PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY (SR-1), IN HUNTINGTON BEACH, CLOSED BETWEEN BEACH BOULEVARD AND GOLDENWEST STREET ON JULY 4TH

Irvine—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will be closing the Northbound and Southbound lanes of Pacific Coast Highway (SR-1) between Beach Boulevard (SR-39) and Goldenwest Street for the annual 4th of July parade and fireworks show in the City of Huntington Beach.

The closure will be from 5:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. and from 7:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m.

This closure is pursuant to a provisional encroachment permit Caltrans has issued to the City of Huntington Beach.
