Full Connector Closure of North State Route 55/West State Route 91 Week of February 10, 2014

Construction crews are widening the connector and will replace existing pavement on the right side of the roadway. The lanes have been reduced from two to one for approximately one month. The connector closure schedule is as follows:

Detours: North SR-55 exit West Lincoln Avenue to Tustin Ave or North Glassell onto West SR-91
North SR-55 exit West Lakeview Ave to West SR-91

The \$46.27 million SR-91 westbound project will add an exit bypass lane and reconstructing the auxiliary lane west of Tustin Avenue. Improvements will also include the reconfiguration of Tustin Avenue Off-ramp to a 4-lane exit, lengthening Tustin Avenue On-ramp with new shoulders, widening of the Santa Ana River Bridge and the installation of retaining walls from Riverdale Avenue to the Santa Ana Bridge. During pile driving operations along the Santa Ana River Bridge, detour signs will be posted for cyclists to use Lakeview Avenue or Riverdale Avenue as alternate routes.

Changeable message signs will be in place to alert motorists of the closures.

Once complete, motorists traveling northbound on SR-55 to the westbound SR-91 connector will have an option to exit Tustin Avenue using the new exit only bypass lane north of the connector, or the general purpose lane.
