## INTERSTATE 405 ASPHALT OVERLAY PROJECT UNDERWAY

**Irvine**—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has an asphalt concrete overlay construction project underway to repair damaged concrete on Interstate 405 (I-405) in Irvine and Costa Mesa.

The project, which covers a stretch of the Interstate 5 (I-5) and I-405 separation to the Harbor Boulevard undercrossing, is expected to be completed by April 2011, with work being conducted from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Saturday. A large portion of the work is also being done from State Route 55 (SR-55) to MacArthur Boulevard, and Jeffrey Road to Sand Canyon Avenue in Irvine. All-American Asphalt of Corona is the project contractor.

The project got underway during the week of October 13, and consists of saw-cutting concrete, the removal and replacement of concrete pavement, the placing of asphalt concrete, and the installation of traffic loops and traffic striping. This work is expected to create a safer and smoother driving surface for motorists.

**Residents are advised that the construction activity could create loud noise volumes during the overnight hours.**

Nighttime detours are in place at the construction locations, and every effort will be made to minimize the impacts of construction to residents and businesses.
