INTERSTATE 5 ROADWAY AND BRIDGE WIDENING PROJECT IN SAN JUAN CAPISTRANO SET TO BEGIN NEXT WEEK

Irvine—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has a construction project set to begin next week, which covers a one mile stretch of the Interstate 5 (I-5) from Camino Capistrano to south of San Juan Creek Road in the city of San Juan Capistrano. The \$13.2 million project is expected to be completed by mid-2013. Beador Construction Company, Inc. of Corona is the project contractor.

To prepare the construction staging area, the contractor will work for the first two weeks with traffic closures from 10pm to 5am to place construction area signs, temporary K-rails, and restripe the main line and ramps. After this staging work is complete, the project will be constructed during day shifts with a few night shifts as required.

The scope of the project includes:

- Construction of a soundwall/retaining wall on Southbound I-5 between Southbound SR-74 on ramp and San Juan Creek bridge
- Widening of San Juan Creek Bridge
- Adding an auxiliary exit lane on Southbound I-5 at Camino Capistrano Southbound off ramp
- Widening Camino Capistrano On and Off ramps
- Construction of a retaining wall between San Juan Creek Road bridge and San Juan Creek bridge
- Widening of San Juan Creek Road bridge
- Widening of Camino Capistrano from San Juan Creek Road for 2,200 feet to the south
