I-5 EMERGENCY SLAB REPLACEMENT CONSTRUCTION

Lake Forest—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will be replacing damaged concrete slabs in the truck bypass lane of the north bound Interstate 5 Freeway in Lake Forest as well as the Lake Forest on and off ramp and the Bake Parkway off ramp.

The project will take place in the overnight hours on Friday July 22 from 10:00pm to 5:00 am and Saturday July 23 from 11:00 pm to 7:00 am.

The project will consist of sawcutting the damaged concrete paving slabs on Friday night and removal and replacement of the slabs on Saturday night

The project is not expected to impact traffic, and construction activity is not expected to create excessively loud noise volumes for residents during the overnight hours. The truck bypass lanes will be closed during this time but trucks will have total access to the mainline lanes with normal height and weight restrictions.

The slabs are being replaced because they have reached the end of their service life and are scheduled for replacement as part of the required maintenance on the freeway system.
