INTERSTATE 5 IN SAN JUAN CAPISTRANO – PILE DRIVING OPERATION TO BEGIN

Irvine— The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has a construction project under way that will require driving piles to construct a retaining wall and widen San Juan Creek Bridge and San Juan Creek Road Bridge. This work will commence the morning of August 1, 2011 from 7 AM to 4 PM and is scheduled to continue Monday through Friday for 10 weeks. This work is being performed to accommodate construction of an auxiliary lane for the Southbound I-5 Camino Capistrano off-ramp. The location of this work is southbound I-5 between the SR-74 (Ortega Highway) on-ramp to the Camino Capistrano off-ramp.

Residents and businesses are advised that the pile driving operation and the use of heavy construction equipment could be noisy and cause vibrations.

As always, to ensure the safety of workers and the traveling public, in a construction zone, please remember to **“slow for the cone zone”, “move over”**, be alert, and proceed with caution.
