CLOSURE OF SOUTHBOUND I-5 TRUCK BYPASS CONNECTOR/ BAKE PARKWAY

Irvine— The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will be closing the Southbound truck Bypass connector/ Bake Parkway on Friday, November 30, 2012 from 9:00 p.m. to Sunday, December 2, 2012 at 3:00 p.m. in the City of Irvine. This closure is to replace joint seal on the bridge.

Changeable message signs will be in place to alert motorists of closure.

Recommended detours:

- Southbound SR-133 to Southbound I-405.
- Exit Alton Parkway and turn left, go to Irvine Center Drive and turn left, proceed to Southbound I-405.
