## OSO PARKWAY BRIDGE WIDENING PROJECT SUSPENDED

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has announced that work on the Oso Parkway Interchange Project's bridge widening on Interstate 5 at Oso Parkway, in the cities of Mission Viejo and Laguna Hills, has been suspended until further notice.

Caltrans officials made the decision to suspend the project to allow the Southern California Gas Company sufficient time to complete the relocation of its 30-inch line. Caltrans anticipates the relocation of the gas line to take anywhere from six to eight months. Construction roadway work (including on and off ramps) will continue as planned during the suspension.

In a construction zone, motorists are reminded to "*slow for the cone zone*" be alert, and proceed with caution.
