SR-1 PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY ROADWAY REHABILITATION PROJECT – TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED

Irvine—The California Department of Transportation’s \$1.8 million roadway pavement rehabilitation project in the city of Laguna Beach, on the Northbound and Southbound lanes of SR-1 Pacific Coast Highway (PCH) from Vista del Sol to Aster Street for five post miles and in the city of Newport Beach from State Park to Newport Coast Drive for two post miles, is temporarily suspended until early March because of expected cold and wet weather during the winter months.

The slurry seal material requires specific temperatures to be applied effectively and settle, and the cold weather conditions make it impossible to produce a quality result. This project would not have normally started so near the holiday season, however, work was required to start immediately as a condition of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funding.

When the work resumes, the entire road from Aster Street to the South City limits will get another coat of slurry seal to provide a smooth surface.

In the meantime, temporary striping will be placed for safety, which will be done during the night from 10pm to 5am.

Due to the State furlough program, Caltrans offices are closed the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Fridays of each month.
